There are eight Grammar Schools in Birmingham and they are extremely popular and entry is very competitive. Not every child achieving the qualifying score can be offered a place.

<b>11+ test dates</b>	Saturday 9th September 2017
<b>Test Types</b>	Two paper approximately 50 minutes each. The papers will be divided into smaller individually timed sections. They comprise of: * Verbal Ability (tests vocabulary, comprehension, verbal reasoning) * Non-Verbal Ability (tests the ability to see how objects relate to each other) * Numerical Ability (tests the ability to solve mathematical problems) * Reading comprehension Most of the questions are multiple choice. The marks will be standardised to take account of differences in age and then added together. Sample questions will be sent to parents on receipt of the completed registration form.
